

Research study looking for MUMS who have had a baby born prematurely- Can you help us better understand relationships and approaches to parenting?

We hope to learn about relationships between parents, and between parents and their children after the premature birth of a child. We are also interested in how these relationships might be associated with parenting, and children's development. This research will help us develop better interventions and support for children and parents after premature birth.

We are looking for mums aged 18 or older whose child(ren) is currently aged 2-5 years and who was born prematurely in an Australian hospital to complete a brief (~20 minutes) and anonymous online survey.

This research has been approved by La Trobe University Human Research Ethics Committee (Ref HEC18187), and is being conducted by Dr Karli Treyvaud (k.treyvaud@latrobe.edu.au), clinical psychologist and senior lecturer at La Trobe University, and three Honours students in the Department of Psychology.
